DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (Worth 45%)

Development Project Oral Presentation (worth 15%):

- 1) Identify and explain the development problem thoroughly
- 2) Provide any relevant background information that contributed to this problem
- 3) Specify why this problem persists and what factors make it difficult to combat
- 4) Offer viable and sound solutions that will potentially resolve this problem
- 5) Consider any possible negative consequences associated with any of the solutions
- 6) Include any pertinent data, charts, tables, and graphs to support your points
- 7) Be creative and imaginative
- 8) Utilize imagery that conveys the problem
- 9) Check grammar and spelling
- 10) Make sure each partner has equal time in presenting *Total presentation time is 20 minutes maximum.

Development Project Written Report (worth 30%):
